Our **Spring** community building/fundraising **activity** will be a "color run." (Though we can't use the terminology, as it is copyrighted--ours will be a **Red & Gold run**.)

We intend to support all other student & teacher lead groups by providing manpower, ideas, & assistance with creating individual community & fundraising activities.

We will provide transportation assistance for the LBCC/OSU field trip again this year, providing funds are available. *Costs will be higher this year due to a change in the format from last year. More details to come.*
